- 2009
- 2010 and younger

Where:

KS Górnik Wieliczka (st. Daniłowicza 6, 32-020 Wieliczka) – natural surface stadium

Sport Myślenice (st. Zdrojowa 9, 32-400 Myślenice) – artificial surface

Wieliczka Athletic Arena (st. Bogucka 9, 32-020 Wieliczka) – artificial surface stadium

Tournament goals:

- Promoting sport and healthy competition among children and young people
- Enabling contestants to make new friends among tournament participants

Participants:

16 teams in the 2009 category (2 groups, 8 teams each)

16 teams in the 2010 category (2 groups, 8 teams each)

Number of contestants:

12 participants + 2 coaches

Tournament timeline:

Saturday: each match will take 15 minutes (no breaks) – GROUP STAGE

Sunday: each match will take 24 minutes (no breaks) – FINAL STAGE A & B

Gameplay system:

The gameplay system is the same for groups of 2009 and 2010. The tournament will

be played in two groups (A and B) consisting of 8 teams each, and the teams will play "everyone against everyone".

The first day of competition - SATURDAY 23.05.2020.

Each team will play 7 matches of 15 minutes each (without breaks). The teams that will take places 1-4 in their group, will advance to the final phase and will compete for places 1-8, and the teams that will take places 5-8 in their groups will compete for places 9-16.

The place in the group is decided based on the following:

- number of points scored
- the result of a direct meeting if there are two teams qualified. In case 3 teams have the same number of points, a "small table" will be prepared. The results obtained between the teams involved are taken into account, then the decision is made upon the following:
- score difference
- bigger number of scored goals
- lesser number of lost goals
- penalty kicks (3)

The second day of competition - Sunday, 24.05.2020.

After the group competition part, teams that scored places 1-4 from group A will play the quarter finals with teams that scored places 1-4 from group B. The teams that scored places 5-8 from group A play with the teams that scored places 5-8 from group B, for places 9-16.

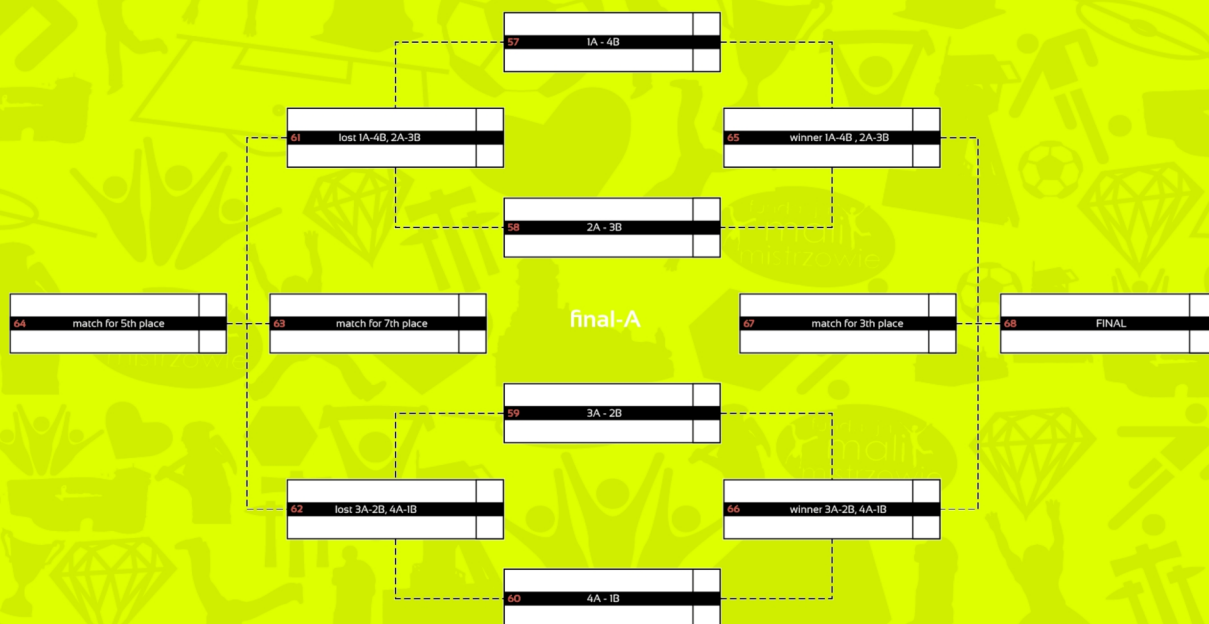

The winners of the above matches will advance according to the graphs attached.



Final phase



Basic regulations:

- A team consists of 12 players maximum
- 6 players plus the goalkeeper play at once

- Time of each match is 15 minutes (Saturday), 24 minutes (Sunday)
- **Instant (hockey type) substitutions in the zone**
- Ball nr 4
- the entry from the goal kick happens from the so-called "**five meter**" line within their own half of the pitch
- **kicked throw-ins**
- time penalties of 2 minutes
- Extremely non-sporting behavior may be punished with a red card. If so, the team plays weakened until the end of the match and the player pauses in the next match.
- Field size 55x25m
- Goals size 5x2m
- **Side throw-ins:** kicked (**initiating** or passing), cannot score a goal directly, the opponent has to be 3m away
- Footwear: soft, so called „lankas“
- Individual penalties: 2 minutes or exclusion (a player finishes the game, his team plays weakened for 2 minutes)
- The offside rule does not apply
- Other regulations in accordance with the Unification for the „orlik“ category (junior E)
- The organizer reserves the right to make changes to the regulations

Prizes:

Teams that took places 1-3 receive cups and diplomas and individuals receive medals. There will also be individual prizes (statuettes, diplomas) for the tournament's top scorer (in both age categories).

The organizer provides:

- water for each team
- refreshments
- qualified medical care

Insurance: Teams participating in the competition insure players at their own expense

Medical examinations and identification documents: teams are required to have valid health cards of their players and identity documents on the day of the competition in order to verify them, the team coach is responsible for the lack of medical examinations.

The organizer does not take responsibility for any accidents before, after or during the competition.

Participation in the tournament is tantamount to giving the organizer consent to the processing of personal data and the image of participants for information and promotion purposes, including social networks and websites.

Registrations for the tournament: By e-mail - confirmation of participation to be sent by 25.08.2019, order of registration decides.

- Additional activities available: visiting the Wieliczka salt mine - to be discussed with the organizer, swimming pool, rope park - to be discussed with the organizer.
