Age category :

- Yearbook 2013 and younger


## Place:

Sport Myślenice (ul. Zdrojowa 9, 32-400 Myślenice) - a pitch with an artificial surface
Dalin Myślenice (ul. Zdrojowa 7, 32-400 Myślenice) - a playing field with a natural surface
Wielicka Arena Lekkoatletyczna (ul. Bogucka 9, 32-020 Wieliczka) - playground with artificial turf

The goals of the tournament:

- Promoting sport and healthy competition among children and adolescents
- Making new friends among tournament participants


## Participants:

24 teams will appear in the tournament (four groups of 6 teams)

## Number of players:

12 players +2 coaches

## Competition time:

On Saturday: 25 minutes each match (without intermission) - GROUP PHASE
On Sunday: 25 minutes each match (without a break) - FINAL PHASE A, B and C

## Game system:

On the first day, the tournament will be played in a system in 4 groups (A, B, C, D) of 6 teams, where the teams will play "peer-to-peer". On the second day, the tournament will be played in a knockout system (Final Phases A, B, C).

## The first day of the competition - SATURDAY, June 8, 2024.

Each team will play 5 matches of 25 minutes (without breaks).
The place in the group is decided in the following order:

- the number of points scored,
- the result of a direct meeting,
- better goal difference,
- more goals scored,
- penalty kicks (three series, in the event of a draw, the next series to be completed)

In the event that 3 or more teams have the same number of points, a "small table" is prepared, in which the order is decided by:
-number of points scored in matches between the teams concerned
-better goal difference in matches between the teams concerned
-the greater number of goals scored in matches between the teams concerned
-better goal difference in all group matches
-the greater number of goals scored in all group matches

## The second day of the competition - Sunday June 9, 2024.

Each team will play 3 matches of 25 minutes (without breaks) in the knockout system in the final stages $A, B$ or $C$

FINAL PHASE
The teams ranked 1-2 in their group will advance to the A Final Stage and will compete for places 1-8 throughout the tournament.

Quarter-final pairs:
1A-2D
1B-2C
1C-2B
1D-2A
Then the teams will play semi-final matches and matches for places 7,5,3 and 1 according to the bracket below.


Teams placed 3-4 in their group will advance to the $B$ Final and will compete for places 9-16 throughout the tournament. The winner of the B-final will receive a small cup as a prize.

Quarter-final pairs:
3A-4D
3B-4C
$3 \mathrm{C}-4 \mathrm{~B}$
3D-4A
Then the teams will play semi-final matches and matches for places $15,13,11$ and 9 according to the bracket below.


Teams placed 5-6 in their group will advance to the Final Stage $C$ and will compete for places 17-24 throughout the tournament. The winner of the C-final will be awarded a small cup.

Quarter-final pairs:
5A-6D
5B-6C
5C-6B

5D-6A

Then the teams will play semi-final matches and matches for places $23,21,19$ and 17 according to the bracket below.


## Final Phase:

## Basic rules:

- A team may have a maximum of 12 players
- Number of players on the field: 6+ goalkeepers
- Duration of the match 20 minutes - group stage, 25 minutes - final stage (no breaks)
- In the event of a tie in the final stage, 3 penalty shoot-outs (in the event of a tie, the next series will be completed)
- FINAL MATCH duration is 30 minutes (without a break). In case of a tie in the FINAL MATCH - Final A (MATCH FOR 1ST PLACE IN THE TOURNAMENT): 10 minutes of extra time (without a break). In case of a tie, 3 penalty shoot-outs (if there is still a tie, additional shoot-outs will be taken).
- 9 m penalty
- Hockey changes in the zone
- Ball number 4
- The offside rule does not apply
- The distance of the opponent from the ball in a free-throw of 5 m
- A throw-in from the goal box is performed with the foot from anywhere in the penalty area. No player of the opposing team may be in the penalty area before touching the ball.
- Side cars are made with the legs by passing the ball. Opponent within 3 m . In the event that the played ball enters the goal without being touched by any player, an indirect free kick takes place from anywhere in the penalty area.
- Time penalties - 2 minutes. Extremely unsportsmanlike conduct may be penalized with a red card. The team plays in weakness until the end of the game, the player pauses in the next game.
- The dimensions of the pitch are $58 \times 30 \mathrm{~m}$
- The dimensions of the goals are $5 \times 2 \mathrm{~m}$
- Footwear: soft, so-called lances
- Other provisions in accordance with the Unification for the eagle category (junior E)
- The organizer reserves the right to introduce changes to the regulations


## Awards:

Teams from places 1-3 of Final Phase A will receive cups, competitors will receive medals. There will also be individual prizes (statuettes, diploma) for the best scorer and goalkeeper of the tournament (players of teams from places 1-8). Each team will receive a diploma for the place they take.

## The organizer provides:

- water for each team
- refreshments
- qualified medical care

Insurance: the participating teams insure the players at their own expense
Medical examinations and identification documents: the teams are required to have valid health cards of their players and identity documents on the day of the competition for possible verification, the team coach is responsible for the lack of medical examinations.

The organizer is not responsible for any accidents before, after or during the competition.

Participation in the tournament is tantamount to giving its organizer consent to the processing of personal data and the image of participants for information purposes and promotion of the tournament on social networks and websites.

## OTHER INFORMATIONS :

- Additional attractions: visiting the salt mine in Wieliczka - to be agreed with the organizer, swimming pool, rope park - to be agreed with the organizer.
