

# **Tournament Rules & Conditions**

### The Organizer:

Mali Mistrzowie NGO

#### **Event time:**

28-29 May 2022

#### Age group:

Born in 2011 or later

#### Venues:

- Sport Myślenice (ul. Zdrojowa 9, 32-400 Myślenice ) football pitch with artificial turf
- Wielicka Arena Lekkoatletyczna (ul. Bogucka 9, 32-020 Wieliczka) football pitch with artificial turf

### The purpous of the event:

- To promote sport and healthy competition amongst children and youths
- Socializing with other players/ making friends

#### Participants:

• 32 teams (4 groups with 8 teams each)

### Numer of players:

12 players + 2 coaches

#### **Duration:**

- On Saturday: each match will last 15 minutes (no break) Group Stage
- On Sunday: each match 25 minutes (no break)- Final stage A,B,C,D

#### **Tournament format:**

First day will follow the round-robin tournament format with 4 groups, 8 teams each. Second day will be based on the knockout system (final stage A,B,C, D)

## <u>Day 1 - Saturday 28 May 2021</u>

Each team will play 7 matches, 15 minutes each (no break) Group ranking will be based on (in order):

- 1. result scoring
- 2. match result
- 3. better goal difference
- 4. the amount of goals
- 5. penalty goals (3 rounds with further ones in case of a tie)

In case 3 or more teams gather the same amount of points, a separate ranking will be created based on (in order):

- 1. the amount of points gathered
- 2. better goal difference
- 3. the amount of goals
- 4. better goal difference in all matches
- 5. higher amount of goals gathered in all group matches
- 6. drawing

### **Day 2 - Saturday 29 May 2021**

Each team will play 3 matches, 24 minutes each (no break) based on the knockout system (final stage A, B, C, D)

### Final stage A

Teams ranked on places 1 and 2 in their group will advance to the final stage A and will compete for places 1-8 in the tournament.



# **Final Stage B**

Teams ranking 3 and 4 in their groups will advance to Final Stage B and will compete for places 9-16 in the tournament.



# **Final Stage C**

Teams ranking 5 and 6 in their groups will advance to final stage C and will compete for places 17-24 in the tournament



# **Final Stage D**

Teams scoring 7 and 8 in their groups will advance to final stage D and compete for places 25-32 in the tournament.

Next teams will play semi-finals as well as compete for places 31,29,27 and 25 (please see the diagram below)

## **Final Stage**

## Main regulations:

- Each team must have a maximum of 12 players
- Number of players in the field: 6+ a goalkeeper
- Duration of matches 15min- group stage, 25 min- final stage (no breaks)
- In case of a tie during final stage there will be 3 rounds of penalty goals (followed by further rounds if needed)
- Penalty goals will be done from 9 meters
- Rolling substitutions (hockey type)
- Ball number 4
- Offside rules do not apply
- Distance between the player and the ball during free kicks 5 meters
- Goal kicks to be performed from the penalty area. Players from the opposite team are not allowed to be present in the penalty area at this point.
- Throw-ins to be performed with legs as passes. Members of the opposite team should keep themselves within 3 meters distance. In case a goal is made without the ball touching any other player, an indirect free kick will be performed from any place within the penalty area.

- Time penalty 2 minutes. In case of an unsporting behavior a red card can be given to a player resulting in his dismissal and not taking part in the next match. The team continues the game without one player.
- Pitch size 55x25m
- Goal size 5x2m
- Footwear: soft football shoes
- Remaining regulations in accordance with Junior E regulations of Polish Football Association
- The organizer reserves the right to change the rules

#### **Prizes**

Teams scoring 1-3 in the final stage A will receive Trophies and players will be given medals.

There will be also special prizes (statuettes and diplomas) for the best goal scorer and goalkeeper of the tournament (players from places 1-8).

Winning teams from final stages B, C and D will receive Trophies.

Each team will receive a diploma.

The organizer provides:

- water for each team
- refreshments
- medical assistance

Insurance: Each team needs to provide insurance to their players.

Medical checks and identity documents: teams are obliged to carry valid medical checks of their players together with ID cards to be verified on the day of the tournament. Team coach will be held responsible in case of lack of medical documents.

The organizer will not be held liable for any injury before, during or after the tournament. By signing up for the tournament teams agree for the processing of their personal data, including image, for informative purposes as well as promotion of the tournament in social media/internet websites.
